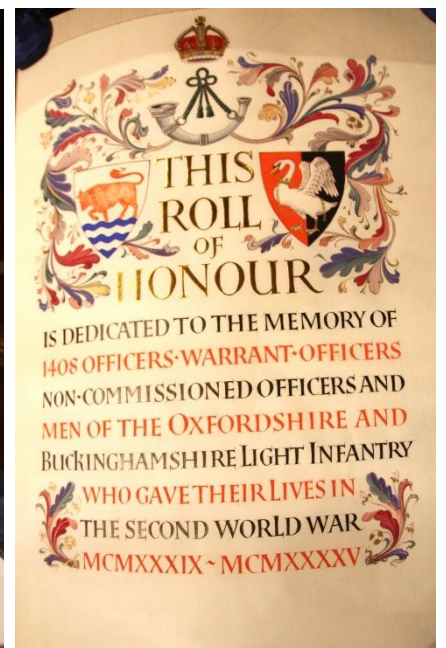
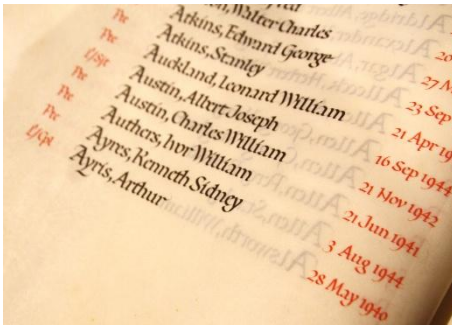


**THE SECOND WORLD WAR BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE

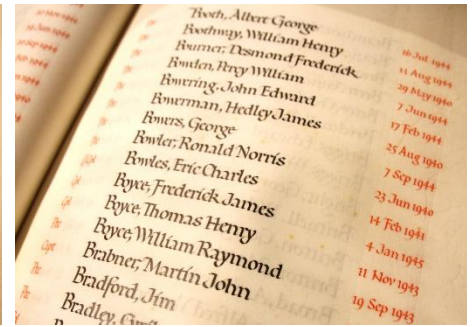
